The Department of Financial Assistance (DFA) provides financial assistance to people who are unable to fund their basic needs. DFA provides financial assistance to individuals and households who demonstrate their financial need based on the eligiblity criteria.

Before applying for financial assistance, applicants should complete the following self-assessment to determine if they may qualify for assistance.
